Out of the Silent Planet 115m, 5.11b

This excellent route in the CMC Valley is located on the wall left of the Ripple wall immediately left of the pillar of Isenguard. It climbs up a prominent shield of steep grey rock. Walk up the scree cone to its apex. This route begins in a corner crack system to the right of the dead tree. Look for a bolt about 6m up.

Gear: Cams to #3 camalot including TCU's and a couple medium wires. 14 draws, several long

P1: 40m 5.10d Climb the steep corner crack passing a bolt until it closes up. Step right and clip bolts up an immaculate, prickly grey slab up to a small roof. Pull over the roof to a stance and good cam placement. Climb left into a groove and follow this to belay at a small ledge.

P2: 20m 5.9 Climb up left from the belay passing a bolt to gain a crack in the right side of a small pillar. Steep moves up the pillar lead to good holds and a stance on top. Clip a bolt and climb the wall above on perfect stone to belay at a small foot ledge.

P3: 35m 11b Step straight up from the belay and clip a bolt out right. Step right to better holds and a short crack. An akward step up right leads to a good hold and another bolt. Difficult moves lead up and left to a rest. Climb the corner above on sustained moves for 10m to a rest at a big hold. Reach straight left to a good hold and commit up and left to gain a foot ledge and a small pillar. Continue up on good holds and fun climbing moving right and up at the last bolt to the belay.

P4: 20m 5.8 Move right from the belay to gain a crack/ groove. Follow this until a step around right leads to another crack which is followed to the top

Descent: Rappel the route from ring bolt stations using 2 ropes. From the top of pitch 3 it is a 55m rappel straight down to the station atop pitch 1.

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
